



| English   | This term in English, the children will be exploring their new book 'The Storm Whale'. This is a fantastic children's book with enticing illustrations, themes of friendship, empathy, and nature. We are going to be thinking in role, writing instructions to help Noi and retelling the story in our own words.   |
| Maths     | Year 1—This term we are going to continue to develop our place value knowledge and addition and subtraction understanding. Year 2 —This term Year 2 will be developing their multiplication and division knowledge and beginning to explore the value of money and how we find change.   |
| Science   | This term in Science, the children will be learning all about living things and their habitats. We will learn that microhabitats are within habitats, explore some microhabitats around the outside area of the school and about how farm-food reaches our plates.   |
| History   | In History this term, we will be exploring Pocahontas. We are going to learn why the English colonists left England and risked their lives in North America, the lives of the Powhatan people in the time of Pocahontas and why Pocahontas is a significant figure of history.   |
| Art/DT    | Children are introduced to the idea that artists often work in partnership and are often inspired by other art forms – in this case music. Children explore how other artists have used sound to inspire their artwork, and then go on to experiment with how they can use their mark making skills to both be influenced by, and to capture, the expression in music. |
| Music     | In the Spring term, Oak class will be getting ready for Young Voices and will spend time practicing the songs ready for the concert. They will also continue to take part in Xylophone lessons with Mr Crocker, expanding their musical understanding and widening their use of musical language.  |
| Computing | The children will be continuing to develop their computing skills this term and will be looking closely at animated story-books. We will be introduced to the world of digital creation, combining creativity with basic computing skills.   |
| RE        | In R.E, the children will be learning about Gospel and we will be looking at the good news that Jesus brings. We will think about different Gospels in the Bible and what these mean to Christians today. We will describe how Christians show their thanks to God and Jesus for the good news and kindness they share with Christians.                                |
| PE        | This term in P.E, the children will be exploring team games and looking at Volleyball. The children will have opportunities to explore the fundamental skills associated with the sport alongside learning the rules involved in participating in the games.   |
