Beech — Term 5

English

This term in English, the children will be exploring their new book 'Arthur and the Golden Rope'. This term we will be focussing on writing a newspaper report and writing letters to Arthur, explaining whether we think he should be the person to go on the quest of not.

Maths

Year 3—This term we are going to continue to develop our skills on fractions, money and time. We will learn how to convert pounds and pence, add money and find change. When learning about time, we will be thinking about how to tell the time to 5 minutes, read the time on a digital clock and solve problems with time.

Science

This term in Science, the children will be learning all about electricity. We will identify common appliances that run on electricity; construct a simple series electrical circuit, identify and naming its basic parts of a circuit. We will also recognise some common conductors and insulators.

History

In History this term, we will be exploring the Vikings! We will identify why the Vikings invaded Britain, What happened at Lindisfarne in 793, Why did Alfred sign a treaty with Gurthum, whether the Vikings were the first Europeans to discover the Americas, who the Norse Gods were and who King Cnut was and why he was important.

Art/DT

In art this term, Beech will be focusing on working with Shape and Colours. They will choose a painting as inspiration which typifies a particular historical period. For example, we will be looking at a painting from the Vikings (Norse Art) and using the skills we learn this term to inspire us for a final project.

Music

In the Spring term, Beech class will continue music lessons with Mr Winston, expanding their musical understanding and widening their use of musical language. They will be thinking closely about crotchets, quavers and different rhythms this term.

Computing

The children will be continuing to develop their computing skills this term and will be looking closely at Lego coding and animation within their computing lessons. We will be thinking about how we create different animations step by step and looking at how we can apply this knowledge to our coding.

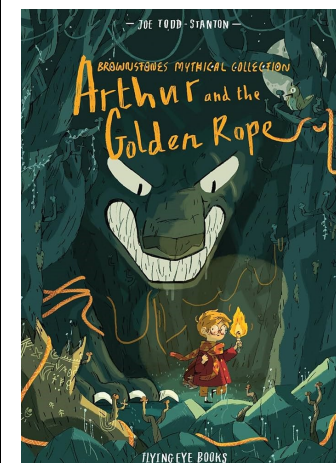
RE
