Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 2 PGL Grosvenor Hall 1 Night Residential – Tuesday 24th to Wednesday 25th February 2026

With 3 weeks left until your child attends their first overnight residential, we wanted to write to you with the final details of your child's stay.

Thank you to everyone who has paid in full. The final balance of £60, was due to be paid by **Friday 30th January 2026**. If you have not paid for the trip in full, please can you pay as soon as possible.

Miss Aitchison and Miss Powell, who you may remember as a student in Oak class, will be attending the trip and accompanying the children, along with Mr Johnson and Mr Hulme. **The group will be leaving school on Tuesday morning.** Please say goodbye to your child at drop-off, as this will enable them to settle into their normal school day at school with their friends and be ready to leave with their teachers via the school minibus. **The children will need to bring a healthy packed lunch with them on this day, as their first meal at PGL will be lunch.**

Can your child please bring a named water bottle, so they are able to take water to each activity they take part in. I have attached a generic copy of the recommended 'kit list' for your children as a reminder, please note that children will need to wear long sleeves and trousers for most activities and long hair must be tied back. Please send clothes and trainers that you don't mind getting muddy and that are easily washable. The children will be taking part in lots of age appropriate and fun activities over the two days. Can you please label all clothing, so that any missing items can be easily located.

Permanent marker pens are great for this! The Centre **WILL NOT** be responsible for any loss of personal property your child brings. Therefore, please do not let them bring anything valuable, including expensive clothing and footwear, mobile phones, handheld games consoles etc. **No electronic devices are permitted.** Your child may wish to bring a book to read, a colouring or writing pad or a card game, for some activities for them to do before bedtime and during other down times.

There is a small shop on site where children can buy snacks and souvenirs and we recommend that children bring no more than £5. **Can all pocket money and medication be given to Miss Aitchison, when you drop your child to school on the morning of the trip, at the back entrance of the school hall. Medication should be in a clearly labelled bag/envelope with your child's name on and instructions for administering, along with your child's luggage. Money can be in a purse, wallet or envelope, with your child's name on it. Please remember that the children are only staying away for one night and a small overnight bag would be ideal. Please no big suitcases.**

The group should be back at school on **Wednesday 25th February for a normal pick-up time of 3:15pm; we will send you a text via Schoolcomms and ClassDojo on the day, should this timing change.** Please check Classdojo over the two days, for regular updates. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.
