Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Residential to Stubbers Adventure Centre, Monday 8th – Wednesday 10th June 2026

We are very much looking forward to your child's upcoming exciting activity break to commemorate their time with us at St. Paul's. This will take place at **Stubbers Adventure Centre, Ockenden Road, Upminster, Essex, RM14 2TY**.

The two night and three days stay, will provide the children with exciting and challenging activities, run by an experienced and qualified team of outdoor professionals. From activities such as archery, abseiling, canoeing, laser combat and pioneering to name but a few, there is bound to be something for everyone! The focus of the residential will be on teamwork; building skills and instilling confidence and persevere for the children, when faced with challenges. The trip is designed, to help prepare the children for their next steps into secondary school. They will gain a great deal from attending this time away and take with them fond memories of Year 6 and their friends at St. Paul's, which they can treasure long after they have left us!

Can you please label all clothing that your child brings, so that any missing items can be easily located. Permanent marker pens are great for this! The Centre and the school, **WILL NOT** be responsible for any loss of personal property your child brings. Therefore, please do not let them bring anything valuable, including expensive clothing and footwear, mobile phones, hand-held games consoles. No electronic devices are permitted. Please pack one sensible bag/case that your child can carry, preferably one that has wheels, as they will need to carry this from the minibus to their room. Your child may want to bring a book to read, a colouring or writing pad or a card game, for some activities for them to enjoy before bedtime and during other down times.

The children will leave St. Paul's on **Monday 8th June** in the morning and will travel on the school minibus. Please say your goodbyes when you drop them to school, as we do not have an exact time for departure and the children tend to settle better, when they say goodbye first thing and leave with their friends. Their first meal at Stubbers will be their evening meal, so please pack a healthy packed lunch for them to travel with, in a disposable bag and a re-fillable drinking bottle for water to use throughout the trip. They will leave Stubbers on **Wednesday 10th June**, at approximately 1:30pm and will arrive back at St. Paul's School for a normal pickup time of 3:15pm. We will keep you updated on the day via ClassDojo or Schoolcomms, should this time change.

The total cost of the trip is **£265**; which includes all activities, food and travel to and from the centre. Thank you for all of the deposits that have been paid. **Please can you continue to pay your child's trip via Schoolcomms under 'Y6 Stubbers Residential June 2026'**. The balance can be paid all at once, or in smaller increments, with a minimum amount for each payment of £5. The payment will remain open until **Friday 29th May 2026**, to give you plenty of time to pay.
