Dear Parents/Carers of Beech Class,

Beech Class Visit to Frameless Immersive Art Exhibition – Tuesday 5th May 2026

The children in Beech class will be learning about light in their science curriculum and the different sources of light and how we see light in our world. In art, they will be learning all about patterns, across a range of different artists and forms of art.

To bring this topic alive, we have arranged to take the children to the **FRAMELESS immersive art exhibition** in Marble Arch, on **Tuesday 5th May 2026**. The address is 6 Marble Arch, London, W1H 7AP.

FRAMELESS, is redefining the experiential immersive art world. Situated in Marble Arch, it is the largest permanent multi-sensory experience in the UK. FRAMELESS features four galleries and showcases some of the world's greatest works of art, presented in ways never seen before. Where art breaks free!

As part of the visit, the children Step inside art itself as they travel through four distinct, immersive galleries, featuring iconic masterpieces from some of the world's greatest artists; Kandinsky, Monet, Dali, Van Gogh, Canaletto, Rembrandt and Klimt to name a few.

We will be travelling by train to and from the museum, from Swanley train station to London Victoria and then a tube to Marble Arch. **Please can you drop your child to the ticket office side of Swanley train station, by 9:20am on the morning of the trip. Please be on time, as we will be unable to wait for any late arrivals. Our return train will depart from London Victoria at 14:42pm and will arrive back at Swanley station at 15:15pm.** Due to the clash with pick-up times for parents with siblings, we will arrange for the children to all be transported from Swanley train station back to school. **We anticipate being back to school for approximately 3:30pm. Please collect your child from school at this time.** Should the return time change on the day, we will alert you via Schoolcomms or ClassDojo.

The children should wear a full school uniform, with a waterproof coat. The children will need a healthy packed lunch, with a refillable drinking bottle of water. Your child will be required to carry their own lunch on the day and a small backpack for this would be ideal. They will not need any spending money.

The cost of the trip is **£18**, which covers the cost of the return train/tube fare and entry to the FRAMLESS exhibition. Please pay via the School Gateway app, under the payment '**Beech Trip May 2026 – FRAMLESS Art Exhibition**'. You can pay in stages, with a minimum amount of £1. We will leave the payment open until **Friday 15th May 2026**, which gives you 7 weeks to pay.
