Y6 Church Schools' Celebration at Rochester Cathedral – Thursday 18th June 2026

We have been invited to attend the above event, which takes place on **Thursday 18th June 2026**.

Children will take part in two activities over the course of the morning, both of which will contribute to the service of worship in the afternoon. These activities will help pupils to understand the Cathedral's history; such as when it was built, why it was built and how it has been a place for prayer and worship, serving this purpose since 1080.

In the afternoon, the Eucharist service will be celebrated by a Bishop and will incorporate elements from the morning. It will also provide an opportunity for pupils to look back to their time at St. Paul's and look forward to their new school and a new part of their life's journey.
