We have arranged for Year 6 to attend an annual interactive safety event at **Cobham Hall School in Gravesend, DA12 3BL, on the afternoon of Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026**. You can find more information on this national event via

It is an interactive event, that invites Year 6 children to attend sessions which help them to become more independent and prepare them for the transition into secondary school. The topics that the event will cover are:

- Fire, Water, Electricity, Road, Passenger and Railway Safety

- Emergency Life Support
- School Attendance
- Exploitation

**The children will need to bring a healthy packed lunch on the day and a water bottle that can be refilled.** They must wear school uniform, including a blazer. The event is held outside under marquees on the grass, so please ensure that the children bring a rain mac should it rain on the day! For hotter weather, sunscreen should be applied before school, and a cap may be worn. There will be no charge for this trip.
